#### **Description:**

Funds will be used for staff hired in 2016 and in 2019 and shall work with landowners to implement conservation practices in the interest of reducing/mitigating/controlling soil erosion on lands within Rock County. Through this grant, the Rock LMO/SWCD will provide/obtain training for this staff to possess/obtain certifications deemed appropriate for providing the services necessary to the landowners within Rock County. This grant will also assist in obtaining the training and certifications necessary to further develop existing staff allowing the Rock LMO/SWCD to provide a higher degree of professional conservation oriented services and expertise to the landowners of Rock County. Training will be provided on NRCS Toolkit, GPS Total Station Survey Equipment, and other resources. Staff will shadow NRCS Field Staff, Jay Murphy (Centrol Consultant and former NRCS Technician), Dawn Madison (Southwest Prairie TSA Consultant and former NRCS Technician), and Southwest Prairie TSA staff and engineer.
