The alternative riparian water quality structural conservation practice will be based on the Natural Resources Conservation Service Field Office Technical Guide.</p> <p>Assistance will include: site assessment, review of alternative practices, flagging, site inspection for compliance, enforcement for non-compliance following procedures defined within the buffer ordinance. Administration will include reporting in BuffCat and ELINK, updates to the SWCD board and any required board approval and signature.</p> <p>Staff will attend any training/meetings for any updates.</p>
